i. Events for 2018-2019

- Staff appreciation May 9th
 - Vendor for event: Option of Native

- Bike Parade/Rodeo
 - Committee is working on details of the rodeo and plans to add a parade element to it
 - Event will be held at RES
 - There will be Safety components (bikes inspection, helmet inspection, stickers for completion)

ii. Grants and other areas of support

- Pollinator Project (Eileen Murphy)
 - Sewing / Create dishtowels with fused backing Eileen has fabric
 - Kids can make pollinators
 - Pattern ties to the pollinator
 - Asking \$88.91
 - All in favor/none opposed
- Mandala Project (Maggie Hanna)
 - Part of measurement unit in 2nd grade
 - Calming, help you focus, can be creative
 - Building math skills through measurements
 - 4 packs of gel pens to color the mandalas
 - Use for details and displays betters
 - Asking \$18.49 per pack = \$73.96
 - All in favor/none opposed
- Vending Machine (Suzanne Lull)
 - Student council earned \$1.5K = need total of \$3.5K (asking for 2K)
 - Scholastic book fair can be used for populating the machine after initial inclusion
 - It'll take 6 weeks to get it delivered
 - Vending machine would be in the lobby
 - Free book incentive
 - Denise Wheeler will organize it
 - Pay it forward; lending library; when they are done with the book...stamp or bookmark
 - All in favor; none opposed

- Question regarding Furniture for the space....committee to look into that
- Plan NH Charrette (Paula Tsetsilas)
 - May 31 Professionals in different aspects (monument and tour land and building sites)...look at Rye Rec/RES/RJH to see how they will be cohesive
 - Community discussion to talk about a specific target area; brainstorm what they want to see in that area; Goal is to create healthy and vibrant community and a place where the community could come together
 - Provide areas for more events, a common building, more accessibility/walkability
 - Plan NH Facilitator and lead will mediate the discussion
 - Volunteers (will require overnight stay) brainstorm and make recommendations (written and visual)
 - Results will be provided to the town on June 1st
 - Total cost = \$7.5K (\$6K + \$1.5K expenses)
 - ❖ Still Need \$1400
 - Heritage commission has been largest donor as \$1K
 - ❖ Asking PTA for \$500
 - Recommendations go to select board
 - Plan is to Implement most attainable suggestions (small wins)
 - It will be up to selectman and zoning board to approve
 - Needs to be added to town budget
 - Discussion around the old TD Bank building there are restrictions on building use but looking into it
 - In the deed (government owned building or bank for 5 years)
 - Rye Rec is looking at activity space at church
 - Will meet with Rye Rec as part of the process
 - 25 yard signs will be put up around town for communication
 - Other forms of communication to get the word out include Email blast, promote via school or PTA, Lions club, Flowers Club, Senior Serve, Library, Rye Reps/Dems
